FOCUS ON NUTRITION KIT DISTRIBUTION




With new tie-ups in Hyderabad, Chennai and Karimnagar, we distributed more than 1000 nutrition kits to cancer patients.

India ranked third after China and the United States of America. GLOBOCAN predicted that cancer cases in India would increase to 20,80,000, accounting for a rise of 57.5 per cent in 2040 from 2020.
