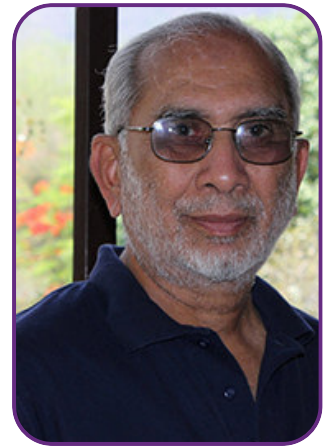

It's a great pleasure to share that this quarter marks a milestone for us. ICS operations have now begun in Telangana and Tamil Nadu, expanding our reach and impact. Oracle volunteers added heart to our mission through joyful Independence Day celebrations with young cancer patients at Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology, a reminder that such compassionate volunteerism is the need of the hour.

In Dharwad, our team pioneered a unique awareness-and-screening model in partnership with KLE College, demonstrating the power of collaboration in rural health outreach (read more on page 2). Across Karnataka, over 12,000 individuals were screened, 11,000+ students reached through anti-tobacco education, and thousands supported with financial aid, nutrition, counselling and prosthetic aids.

Our Emotional Support team strengthened their skills at a Pediatric Psycho-Oncology conference, while Dussehra celebrations at ICS Karnataka brought colour, unity and cheer, closing the quarter with renewed hope and purpose.
