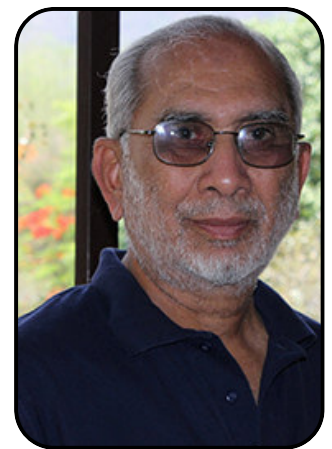

April Pride Month



To observe LGBTQ+ Pride Month, we conducted an oral cancer screening camp at BBMP Maternity Hospital, Bengaluru, with the support of AstraZeneca and in collaboration with the Family Planning Association of India (FPAI).

A total of 45 beneficiaries, including 40 transgender persons, were screened.

One oral cancer suspect was identified, two individuals received tobacco cessation counselling, and all participants were counselled on oral health, reinforcing the importance of early detection and equitable access to preventive healthcare.
